Key Responsibilities:

- Provide technical support for the Gen AI applications that have been developed by Gateley and ensure that they have been appropriately documented.
- Assist with the implementation of the Gen AI applications that have been developed by Gateley.
- > Make small improvements / changes to the Gen AI applications. The improvements might be to reflect functional enhancements, or a switch from one GPT model to another, or similar.
- > Collaborate with Gateley's software engineering team, including participating in code reviews and contributing to the improvement of software development processes.
- Collaborate with cross-functional teams to identify opportunities to improve the Gateley business with Al-based applications, including improvements to current workflows.
- The above list is not exhaustive. Given the relatively small size of the AI team and continued rapid changes in the AI technology environment, it may be necessary for the role holder to engage in a wide variety of tasks.
